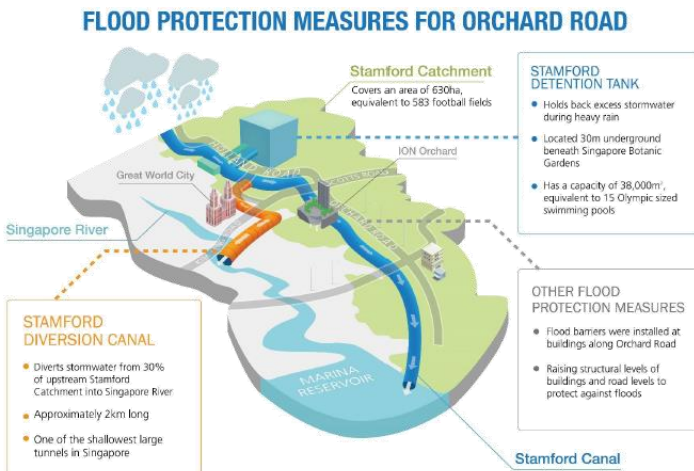

CLIMATE ACTION Stamford Diversion Canal and Stamford Detention Tank

Singapore has been investing in infrastructure to adapt to climate change. The newly operational Stamford Diversion Canal and Stamford Detention Tank will strengthen existing flood protection measures. The tank can hold up to 15 Olympic-sized swimming pools worth of stormwater.

CLIMATE ACTION A Greener Changi Airport

Singapore's Changi Airport achieved Level Three in the Airport Carbon Accreditation programme in May this year. Between 2016 to 2017, Changi Airport undertook more than 10 eco-friendly initiatives. These included: installation of solar panels; rooftop sensors to detect sunlight and control skylight panels – reducing the need for artificial lighting; and using food waste digesters to convert more than 250 tonnes of food into water last year.
