At the Asia Clean Energy Summit on 31 October 2018, Mr Masagos Zulkifli shared key developments in Singapore's clean energy space – such as how recent investments are expected to generate around 1,000 jobs and S\$180m in annual business spending over the next 5 years; and the launch of a Request for Information for a 100 Megawatt peak commercial floating solar photovoltaic (PV) system at the Kranji Reservoir.
